RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Only current members of the NJAA and MJAA who are at least 14 years of age will be considered for this award.
2. The Outstanding Leadership Award Report Form and letters of recommendation are due to the Jim Scharpe by March 1 of the current year. A committee from the Minnesota Angus Association and/or outside of the organization will select recipient. The recipient will be recognized at the Annual Banquet held in March.
3. A member may receive this award only once.
4. The individual applying may complete the form or another person may nominate the individual.
5. The Minnesota Award winner will be asked to submit an application for consideration for the National Leadership Award.

PROCEDURE

On separate sheets of paper, please answer the following questions. Please use only one page for each question, and no more than one page.

Items to be included on this form should be examples of innovative projects and activities instigated and/or implemented by the nominee rather than merely attendance at workshops and activities.

1. Give examples of significant contributions you have made to the Angus program particularly within your state association. **25 points**
2. Give examples of how you have used personal Angus accomplishments to help others achieve and explain how this has aided in their development as a leader. **35 points**
3. Give examples of any other types of outstanding leadership demonstrated within your community, church, professional organizations and school. **20 points**
4. Two letters of recommendation must be attached detailing your attitude, contributions to the overall Junior Angus Association and worthiness of receiving the MJAA Outstanding Leadership Award recipient. One of the recommendations is to be within the Angus industry and the other is to be outside of the Angus industry. **20 points**
